



REQUIREMENTS LIST FOR WORKSHOP

OFF CENTRE LOG CABIN QUILT

A Piecing Workshop.

Quilting experience level - you must be able to sew an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam

Finished Size of Quilt 60" x 80"

Sewing machine

$\frac{1}{4}$ " foot

Normal sewing supplies (needles, thread, pins etc)

Iron and small ironing board

Wooden irons will be available in class for \$5, (but we still need electric irons)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Fabric must be 42" wide or bring more fabric.

This quilt looks best made in two strongly contrasting fabrics –

Dark for the narrow strips – 3.75 metres

Light for the wider strips – 3.3 metres

Before coming to the workshop cut

6 strips across the DARK fabric $1\frac{1}{4}$ " wide

8 strips across the LIGHT fabric 2" wide

This will allow you to make 4 blocks early in the workshop to understand how the design develops.

If you want to make the quilt in scrap fabrics you will need 4 dark fabrics and 4 light fabrics with a strong contrast between the lights and the darks. You do not need equal amounts of each fabric but bring more than the amounts stated above where the use of the fabric is optimised.

For Scrap fabrics only

Cut 2 strips of each DARK fabric 1 ¼" wide

Cut 2 strips of each LIGHT fabric 2" wide

Bring ALL the fabric to class and maybe some clip lock plastic bags to keep the small pieces together.
