1 – Day Workshop (6-hour day)
Experienced Beginner Onward

Quilt-As- You-Go is the easy way to make large quilts in smaller pieces and then join these pieces together into the finished quilt. Three different methods for joining quilt-as-you-go pieces together will be covered. This workshop is perfect for quilters that find large quilts very difficult to handle, or have limited space to machine quilt. Must have some free-motion machine quilting experience.

REQUIREMENTS LIST:

All fabric 40"-42" wide.

Top fabric 1(one) metre (plain light colour)

Backing fabric 1(one) metre

Batting 42" x 28" (best if fairly thin) (1m x 70cm)

If you want to make small samples of the techniques to jog your memory later, bring an extra 1/4 metre fabric and four small (9" x 4") pieces of batting.

Sewing machine and sewing supplies

Safety pins

Rotary cutter, matt and ruler

Walking foot, darning foot and all normal sewing feet

Marking pen or pencil – check it comes out of your fabric

Hand sewing needle

Threads * can be either to match the top fabric or to contrast – it depends on your machine quilting skills and your preferences,

* to match backing fabric

Extension cord and power board/double adapter
