



QUILTED TABLERUNNER / WALLHANGING

12" X 36" Tablerunner

One Day Workshop (6 hour day)
Experienced Beginner/Intermediate Machine Quilter
You MUST be able to free-motion machine quilt.

This table runner with either simple Open feather wreaths or Traditional feather wreaths, is an excellent way to perfect your free-motion skills. A choice of background fillers (not stipple) will be shown.

Depending upon your skills you should get to binding the tablerunner in the day.

REQUIREMENTS

1.1 metre plain pale coloured fabric 42" wide

One piece thin batting 16" x 40"

AND

Scrap fabric and batting to make a small fabric sandwich (approx. 12" square) to trial the different background fillers on and keep as a sample.

Sewing machine in top working order

All machine feet – especially walking foot and darning foot

All normal sewing supplies – scissors, spare needles, straight pins etc.

Fine thread to match your fabric

24" Rotary cutting ruler AND 12" school ruler

Safety pins (approx. 50)

Extension cord and/or power board

You will need to cut the fabric for the wall hanging BEFORE coming to the workshop –

One piece 14" x 38"

One piece 16" x 40"

Three strips 2" x 42" for the binding
