



TRAPUNTO AND CORDED QUILTING WORKSHOP

One day workshop (6 hour day)

Quilting experience level required – Intermediate Quilter and Above

No basic free-motion quilting instruction will be given in this workshop.

Trapunto and Corded quilting add extra texture and loft to your machine quilting. They are both easy and fun to do. We will be making small samples in the workshop that can be made into cushions or small wall hangings.

Patterns will be provided in the workshop.

REQUIREMENTS LIST

2 metres cream or white homespun fabric

2 reels cream or white thread

1 reel monofil thread - YLI, or Sew-All, or Maderia brands

Optional - Washout Basting Thread

1 ball thick (12 ply) cream or white knitting yarn

One 4mm twin needles Size 80/12

1 hand wool needle (a large eyed, blunt pointed needle)

2 fabric marking pens or pencils

1 square metre flat cotton/poly batting (or large pieces)

½ metre puffy or thick polyester batting (pieces available in class for \$1 each)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Approx. 100 safety pins and a few dressmakers' straight pins

Masking tape

Sharp scissors for cutting batting (but not your best shears)

Sewing machine

Darning foot (essential)

Satin stitch foot or normal zigzag foot

Normal sewing supplies for sewing machine – needles, pins, bobbins, etc.

Extension lead/ power board/ double adaptor, whatever you have.
